RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Coosa County Commission was awarded \$200,000 from the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Agency (ADECA) Community Development Block Grant-COVID, and the funds have specific criteria that must be met; and

WHEREAS the Coosa County Commission agreed that the funds should be used to support eligible projects throughout the county amongst each district which have been recommended by each district commissioner. Eligible activities were to address a CDBG program National Objective and assist in preventing, preparing for, or responding to the COVID-19 pandemic and other infectious disease; and

WHEREAS certain activities completed using the allotted funds were determined as disallowed by ADECA because they did not address a CDBG program National Objective and assist towards preventing, preparing for, or responding to the COVID-19 pandemic and other infectious disease; and

WHEREAS ADECA determined that the disallowed activity costs were to be returned before the completion of the grant. Coosa County Commission has agreed to return the disallowed activity costs and complete the specified activities in the grant. The total amount to be de-obligated is \$57,418.50; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Coosa County Commission hereby de-obligates the sum of \$57,418.50 to be returned to ADECA.

FURTHERMORE, the Coosa County Commission authorizes the Chairman to work with the East Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission as needed in order to complete the specified activities of this grant.
