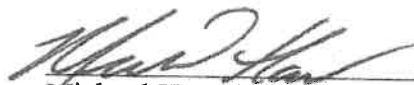

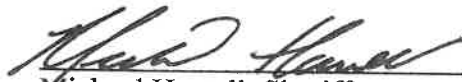

JOINT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there exist Peckerwood Creek Trail, a Talladega County Road that 0.30 miles exist in Coosa County, and;

WHEREAS, Coosa County is charged the responsibility for control and maintenance of Peckerwood Creek Trail within Coosa County limits, and;

WHEREAS, Coosa County and Talladega County desire to enter into a mutual agreement providing for Talladega County to make improvements to the Coosa County Portion of Peckerwood Creek Trail within the limits of Coosa County, and;

WHEREAS, Talladega County will repair and double surface treat the road shown in Exhibit A at a reimbursement cost of \$12,000.00 from Coosa County, in consideration, Coosa County **will** continue to control and maintain the portion of Peckerwood Creek Trail located within Coosa County, and;

WHEREAS, Coosa County Agrees to reimburse Talladega County the sum of \$12,000.00 to Talladega County within two months of the completion of the project.

BASED upon the mutual benefits to each party and to the public that will be traveling on the Peckerwood Creek Trail;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that in consideration for the paving and repairs of Peckerwood Creek Trail, more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made part hereof by this reference, Coosa County continues to control and maintain their 0.30 miles on Peckerwood Creek Trail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this arrangement for control and maintenance of certain public roads within the corporate limits of Coosa County shall continue from this Date, June 8th 2026, until the parties hereto mutually agree otherwise.
