ARTICLE 7 LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS

SECTION A SEVERABILITY

If any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way effect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION B ENFORCEABILITY OF ORDINANCE AND FUTURE REVISIONS

The provisions within this Ordinance must be legally enforceable; applied uniformly throughout the community to all privately and publicly owned land within any regulated flood hazard areas; meet the minimum standards set forth in §60.3 of the Code of Federal Regulations Title 44; and the community must provide that the provisions of this Ordinance take precedence over any less restrictive conflicting local laws, ordinances, or codes.

If the Coosa County Commission repeals its floodplain management regulations, allows its regulations to lapse, or amends its regulations so that they no longer meet the minimum requirements set forth in §60.3 of the Code of Federal Regulations Title 44, it shall be suspended from the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The community eligibility shall remain terminated after suspension until copies of adequate floodplain management regulations have been received and approved by the Federal Insurance Administrator. To avoid such occurrences, the Coosa County Commission will coordinate with the Alabama NFIP State Coordinator and FEMA Regional Office prior to any revisions to this Ordinance. Without prior approval of the Federal Insurance Administrator, the community shall not adopt and enforce revised floodplain management regulations.

From time-to-time Part 60 of the Code of Federal Regulations Title 44 may be revised to advance flood risk reduction measures as experience is acquired under the NFIP and new information becomes available. The Coosa County Commission agrees to revise its floodplain management Ordinance to comply with any such changes within six months from the effective date of any new federal regulation.
